## DIGITAL PASSPORT ASSIGNMENT

Fluency with digital tools is essential in this course, and a great advantage in the career and college life that lies ahead of you. You will be expected to find information, communicate, and produce mathematics both by going online and using software.

On or before Tuesday, September 2, please do all of the following:

- 1. Visit the class website, <a href="http://mathlore.net">http://mathlore.net</a> and look at the various pages there: Alg2ma, Rules, Grades, Contact, Reference, and so on.
- 2. Go to the class Moodle page, following either the link on the Alg2ma page or some other route. Log in, and look at the page. Your login and password is the same as the one you use on any campus computer. *Caution!* You may need to log in to a campus computer (changing your password) *before* logging in to Moodle from off-campus. If Moodle asks you for an enrolment key, it is "Friend" (without the quotes.) If you have not used Moodle before, it may also ask you for some basic information as well.
- 3. On the class Moodle page, in the week 24 Aug 30 Aug, you will see *two* tasks that must be completed: "Login Task," and "Online Student Survey." Do *both*.
- 4. Class notices will be sent using the "Remind" system. Go to <a href="https://www.remind.com/join/lhsalg2ma">https://www.remind.com/join/lhsalg2ma</a> and choose whether to be notified by cellphone text message, or email. In either case, I will have no record of your phone number or email address. You may use your school email address, if you check it or have it forwarded to some place you do check.
