## Reading Utility Meters

## Example



Begin with dial A. Read the number that the pointer has just passed. Then read dial B . If the pointer is between numbers take the lower number. Even though the pointer appears to be exactly on a number, read the next lower number-unless the pointer to its right has passed zero. Dials $C$ and $D$ are read in the same way as dial $B$.

The dials here read 2539 .
