

Best Bank Sweepstakes, part one

Your assignment is gather information to help our class determine if there is a “best bank” in our area. You must gather some key information from an area bank, preferably one where you already have an account of some sort.

The first part of this assignment is due on Monday, November 15th. You are to collect some information that we can compare to similar information from other students (gathered from other banks.)

You are to compare *at least* five types of accounts: checking, ATM, savings, certificate of deposit, debit card, and so on.

Information should be in a *well-organized* table showing: type of account, the interest rate for the account, account requirements, and other account metrics, costs, and benefits.

This information can be obtained by visiting the bank. They usually have brochures describing accounts offered, and a “board” in the lobby listing current interest rates. This information can also be obtained in most cases by visiting the bank’s website. Be sure to include the brochures you gather, or website printouts with your report.

If you are unsure whether the material you are collecting is appropriate or sufficient, show it to Mr. Petto on or before Friday, November 12.
