

Electronic Submission of Writing Assignments

You may obtain extra credit by turning in any assignment using a computer.

Any assignment that is submitted electronically will receive 10% scoring bonus. (This applies to writing assignments, extra credit reports, problems of the week, homework and team projects.)

Files can be attached to an email message sent to:

(FYI, this address relays your message to my LHS inbox, and sends a copy to me at home.)

Filenames should be of the form:

Student Name - Assignment Title.ext

For example:

Pat Doe - First Short Biography.doc

Microsoft Word (.doc or .docx) or Adobe (.pdf) are preferred file formats.

If you are at a computer on campus, you can copy-and-paste a file that you *first create in your own home directory* into my folder in the LHS Completed Assignments directory. Ask me to show you how to do this if you're unsure. (It takes some practice.) Afterward, drop me a note with the name of the file, and the date you placed it, ASAP.

I am also experimenting with receiving assignments via fax. See the MathLore "Contact" page. If there is a working fax number there, go ahead and use it.

Talk with me if you have any questions about any of this; particularly if you need advice about typing mathematical notation.
